

Bellville ISD Schools Earn State Highest Accountability Marks

Bellville ISD schools continued to shine, earning 6 state distinctions with all eligible schools earning the state's highest accountability standard, according to a release from the Texas Education Agency (TEA).

TEA announced the results from the 2016-17 state accountability system and all 5 Bellville ISD schools earned the state's Met Standard rating.

We are proud of our students, teachers and families for all student success. State accountability is a necessary component of our education system, but our focus as educators in Bellville ISD will continue to be the success of the whole child.

[State accountability measures schools are based on performance](#) on the State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR), End-of-Course Exams, and graduation rates across four indices – student achievement, student progress, closing performance gaps and postsecondary readiness.

Schools can earn distinctions for performance as compared to a group of 40 similar schools across the state based on demographics.

The following campuses earned distinctions:

- Bellville High School for ELA, Math and Science
- Bellville Junior High for Math
- OBI for Reading/ELA
- West End for Top 25% Student Progress
